

**EDGEWATER YACHT CLUB  
2023 SUMMER SAIL CAMP**

**PURPOSE**

The intent of this program is to instruct young people in all aspects of the sport of sailing from basic boat handling through performance sailing. For interested young sailors, the opportunity for race instruction is also provided. The focus of the program will be on safety, basic seamanship, and "rules of the road". All campers should have a real desire to learn to sail or advance their sailing skills.

**ELIGIBILITY**

**Registration is open to the children of Edgewater Yacht Club members** and non-members alike **with members having priority application acceptance in the months of January and February**. Campers must turn eight (8) years on in the calendar year they attend camp, and no older than 18 years old.

**DATES**

The 2023 Summer Sailor Camp will hold one 6 week long session. Camp will begin on **Monday, June 12th, and end Friday, July 21st**. **INSTRUCTION**

Classes will be conducted by USSA (United States Sailing Association) Level certified instructors. The program will emphasize on-the-water instruction as well as boat maintenance. Sailors are divided into three groups based on their age, weight, and sailing experience from beginners through intermediate. (Sailors with advanced sailing skills may join the EYC Junior Race Team)

**EQUIPMENT**

Each participant shall provide and wear his/her own Coast Guard-approved life jacket. In addition, each participant should have a raincoat, change of clothes, appropriate shoes, and lunch every day. On-the-water instruction will be conducted in the Club-owned Collegiate 420s, Optimists, and Sail Cubes.

## 2023 JUNIOR SAIL CAMP RESPONSIBILITY CONTRACT

### I. Parents' Responsibilities

- A. Provide appropriate gear every day: USCG approved life jackets, raincoats, dry change of clothes, appropriate shoes, sunscreen, etc.
- B. Provide a bagged lunch, or make arrangements to purchase lunch from the Club, and provide plenty of liquids. *Club kitchen is CLOSED for Monday lunches.*
- C. Arrange for arrival no earlier than 8:45 AM and pick up no later than 5:15 PM.
- D. Support of sailing skills the child has learned.
- E. Support of disciplinary action if needed.

### II. Parental Consequences

- A. No child will be allowed to participate in any activity without a **USCG approved life jacket**.
- B. If disciplinary actions are not effective, the child will be terminated from the program with no refund of fees.
- C. If arrival or pickup times force the Club to provide supervision, a fee of \$10.00 per half hour before or after camp will be charged.
- D. If a student's willful or reckless activity, as determined by the Program Supervisors, causes damage to boats or equipment, the cost of repair or replacement will be at the expense of the student's parents or guardians.

### III. Camper's Responsibilities

- A. **RESPECT** other people's property.
- B. **OBEY** Instructors.
- C. Use appropriate language. (Profanity will not be tolerated)
- D. Be conscious of safety. (Yours and others)
- E. Leave boats in ship-shape condition.
- F. Wear an approved life jacket when near the water.
- G. **Wear approved shoes at all times. (Sandals and flip-flops are not permitted)**
- H. Do not touch or take any possessions that are not yours.
- I. Possession and/or use of alcohol, drugs, or tobacco is strictly forbidden on Club premises and at all Club sanctioned events.

### IV. Camper's Consequences \*

- A. First, a verbal warning will be given and recorded. Parents will be contacted.
- A. Second, the camper will be required to stay home for one program day.
- B. Third, will be the expulsion from the program.
- C. Possession and/or use of alcohol, drugs or tobacco will result in immediate disciplinary action.
- D. If a student's willful or reckless activity, as determined by the Program Supervisors, causes damage to boats or equipment, the cost of repair or replacement will be at the expense of the student's parents or guardians.

\* **These steps are not necessarily progressive. A student may be expelled without prior warning.**
